### **Loudoun Board of Supervisors Honors Constitutional Officers**

The Loudoun County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution that honors Loudoun's constitutional officers by recognizing the week of January 18 – 22, 2010, as Constitutional Officer Week in Loudoun County. The constitutional officers include the following elected officials:

- Clerk of the Circuit Court – Gary M. Clemens
- Commissioner of the Revenue – Robert S. Wertz, Jr.
- Commonwealth's Attorney – James E. Plowman
- Sheriff – Stephen O. Simpson
- Treasurer – H. Roger Zurn

In the resolution recognizing these constitutional officers, the Board cited the important duties of these offices which include the maintenance of public records, operation of circuit courts, prosecution of criminal cases, protection of public safety and the administration of local revenues. The constitutional officers embody Thomas Jefferson's ideal form of representative democracy which provides for direct accountability to the people by virtue of the people's right to vote for the constitutional officers. The resolution also points out the new standards of customer service, innovative service delivery and responsiveness that constitutional officers emulate.
