2012 COMMUNITY BLUE RIBBON AWARD NOMINATION FORM

BACKGROUND:

The Loudoun County Joint Architectural Review Board (JARB) nominates projects in a variety of categories to showcase outstanding efforts of Historic Preservation in each of the locally designated historic districts throughout the County. This year, the JARB is also soliciting nominations from the Loudoun County community for a new category of recognition, to be awarded at the 2012 JARB Awards Ceremony in May. In an effort to expand recognition of preservation efforts county-wide, nominations will be accepted for any preservation or restoration project in Loudoun County.

ELIGIBILITY:

The project must be physically located in Loudoun County or an incorporated Town (Hamilton, Hillsboro, Leesburg, Lovettsville, Purcellville or Round Hill) and construction must be **completed** by the time the nomination is submitted to the JARB for consideration. Projects need not have been completed in the most recent calendar year (2011) in order to be eligible. Past winners are not eligible for a second award.

Projects must exemplify the preservation of a historic resource, landscape, or significant cultural resource. An eligible project might consist of a sympathetic addition to an historic building, a restoration or rehabilitation project, an adaptive reuse of an historic building, the preservation of a significant archeological site or some other project which otherwise protects or enhances one of Loudoun County's historic or cultural resources.
