Hello, Loudoun

Loudoun, I am aware there are concerns that the vaccines are not going out fast enough. Let me give you COVID-19 numbers and vaccine information.

COVID-19 in Loudoun:

- Total Cases: 15,443 + 874 since January 4th
- Total Hospitalizations: 688 + 14 since January 4th
- Total Deaths: 164 + 3 since January 4th
- 17.7% Positively Rate
- Total Recoveries: over 15,000

Vaccines in Loudoun:

Loudoun has no vaccines that have gone unused. All vaccine is being used. Loudoun County is distributing 500 doses per day. IMPORTANT: That number only includes Loudoun County government. Private hospitals and congregant care facilities are NOT included in that number. Until today, Loudoun was only authorized for Phase 1a vaccinations. As of Monday, January 11th, we start Phase 1b: Frontline Essential Worker vaccinations. This authorization will allow us to scale up vaccinations. 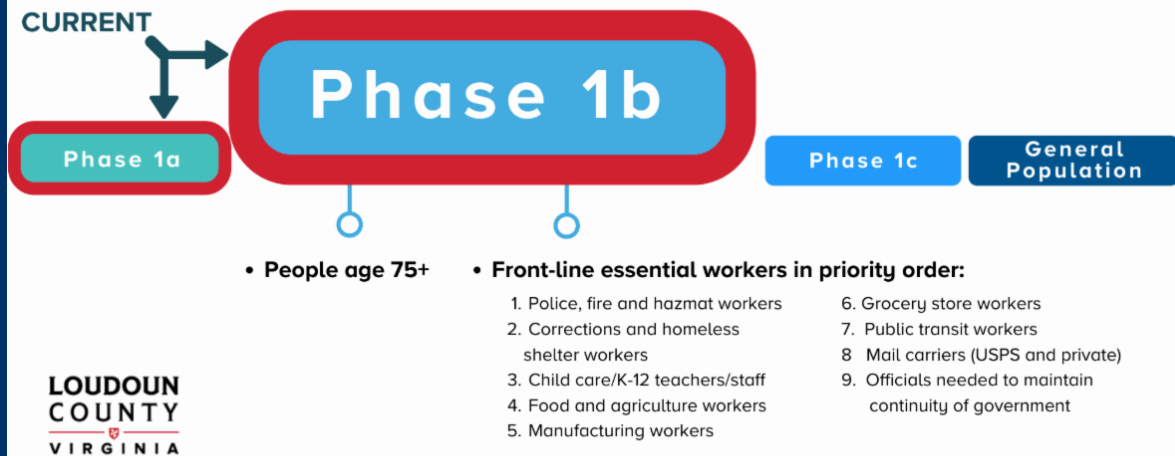
Phase 1b includes:

- All other first responders
- Corrections and homeless facilities
- Food and agriculture workers
- Manufacturers
- Grocery store workers
- Public transit workers
- Mail carriers
- People 75 and older
- Government infrastructure personnel
- School staff K-12/child care

Initially, the Loudoun County Health Department will be coordinating or providing these vaccinations. As we move forward, vaccine will become increasingly available through people's health care providers and local pharmacies. NOTE: If you are 75 years old or older, please contact your Primary Care Provider (PCP). If you don't have a PCP, please contact the Loudoun County Health Department at health@loudoun.gov or call the COVID-19 information line at 703-737-8300 between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm.

LCPS is using school nurses to vaccinate LCPS employees. The County is not overseeing LCPS vaccinations.
