02/09/2021	Waterford	Fake Check Scam: The complainant reported that he was contacted to do a side job and was sent a check for the work. The check was written for considerably more than the cost of the job. The customer advised the complainant to send the difference back using a cash app. After the complainant sent the money back, he learned that the check was fake. This case remains under investigation. SO2100002667
02/12/2021	Sterling	Phishing: The complainant reported that he was talking with a person he met online (using an app), shortly after, he began receiving messages from people demanding that the complainant send gift cards for "wasting her time". The complainant purchased the gift cards. SO2100002700
02/16/2021	Round Hill	Cash App Scam: The complainant reported receiving an email for suspicious charges to her PayPal account. She called the number provided in the email and the person instructed her to click on a link, which then provided the scammers access to her information. The scammers told her to fix this she was to purchase gift cards and provide the card information to them over the phone, in which she did. SO2100002689

LANDSCAPING

Your home's landscaping should provide maximum visibility to and from your house. Trim shrubbery that could conceal criminal activity near doors and windows. Provide lighting on areas of dense trees and shrubs that could serve as hiding places. Cut back tree limbs that could otherwise help thieves climb into windows.

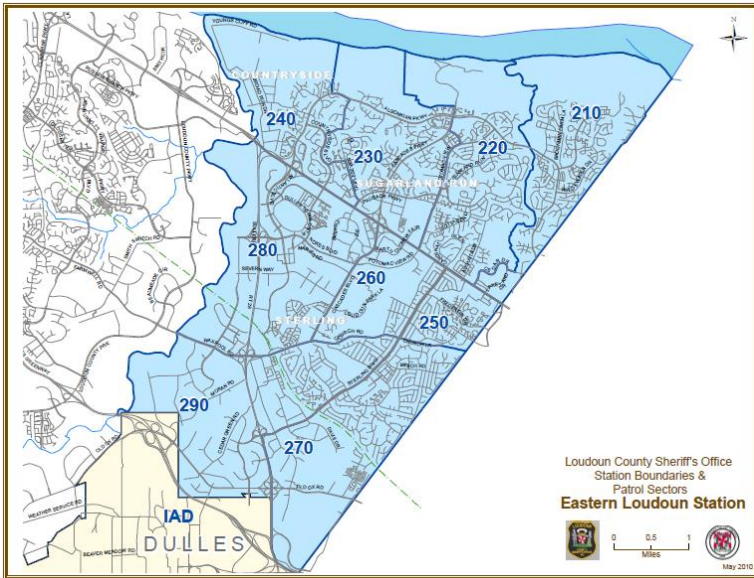


Planting bushes or flowers such as roses, that have thorns is a great option for under windows. Thieves will be less likely to gain entry to the house if they have to climb through the bushes with thorns.

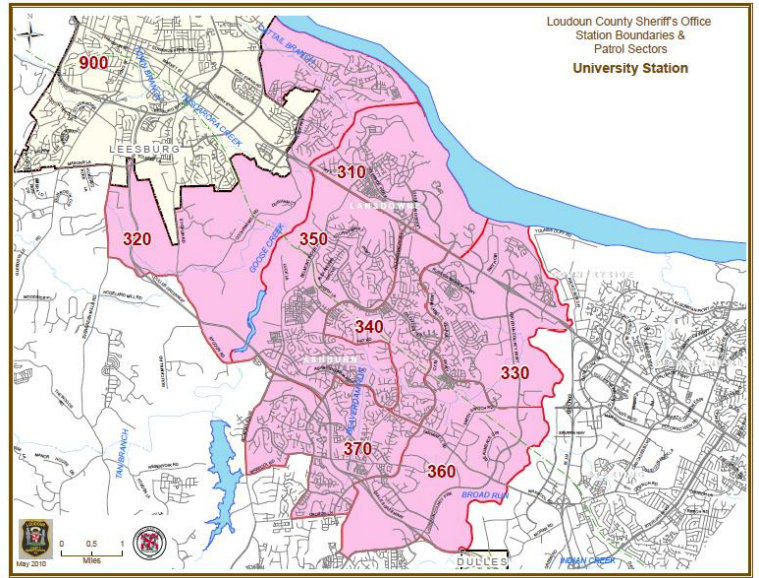

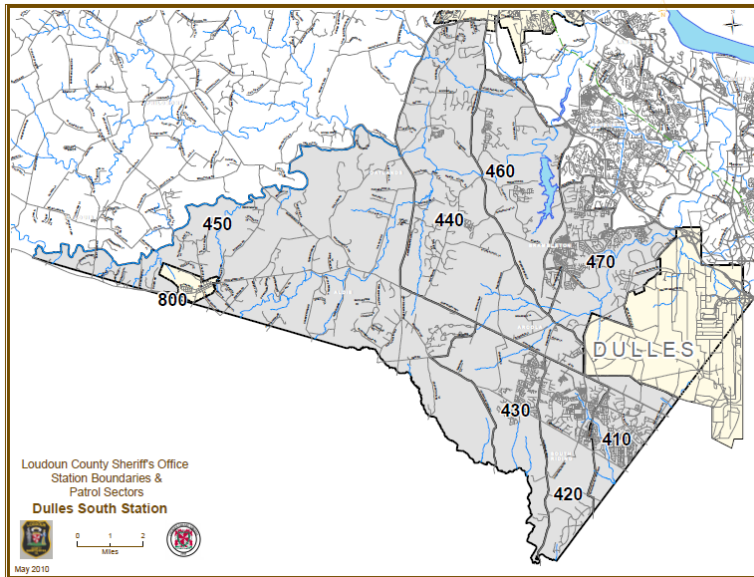
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
