Sterling	<b>Destruction of Property:</b> This morning the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office responded to multiple reports of vandalism at the Potomac Run Plaza and at Cascades Overlook that occurred sometime during the overnight or early morning hours. The windows of multiple businesses (Miller Ale House, Outback, Mattress Firm, Panera, Chuy's Mexican Restaurant) and a vehicle were damaged. The windows were damaged with rocks. No entry was made into any of the locations. The incidents remain under investigation.
09/01/2020 – 03/02/2021	45900 block Old Ox Rd. Sterling	<b>Larceny:</b> The complainant reported that the storage space he was renting had been entered and items were removed. This case remains under investigation. SO2100003405
03/02/2021 – 03/03/2021	600 block E. Charlotte St. Sterling	<b>Vehicle Tampering:</b> The complainant reported that someone moved his vehicle approximately 30 feet by releasing the parking brake. There was no sign of forced entry. SO2100003423.
03/02/2021 1:00 pm	100 Free Ct. Sterling	<b>Disorderly / Assault:</b> Deputies responded to the DMV for a report of a disorderly customer. Upon arrival it was learned that a customer was pulling on a credit card machine and a security guard hired by the DMV, confronted the customer. As the customer was attempting to leave, the security guard forcibly detained him and began striking the customer with a baton. The customer was transported to a local area hospital for treatment of his injuries.  The security guard, Sani Barua, 34 of Alexandria was charged with Unlawful Wounding and transported to the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center where he was released on his own recognizance. A firearm belonging to the victim was located at the scene.</p> <p>The circumstances surrounding the shooting remain under investigation and there is no indication there was a threat to the community.</p> <p>Anyone with any information regarding this incident is asked to contact the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office at 703-777-1021. 03/01/2021	Sterling	<b>Law Enforcement Scam:</b> The complainant reported receiving a call from someone claiming to be with Border Patrol and told him that a package had been intercepted that was addressed to the complainant. The caller also advised the complainant that his bank accounts had been compromised and that he would be receiving a call from the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office (LCSO). A few minutes later the complainant received another call from someone claiming to be with the LCSO telling him to clear up the matter he needed to purchase gift cards and provide the card information to them, which he did. 03/02/2021	Ashburn	<b>Bank Scam:</b> The complainant reported a phone call from an individual claiming to be with his bank. The caller told the complainant to download software to his account. As soon as the software was downloaded on the computer charts and graphs flooded his computer screen. The caller told him the only way to clean the computer was for him to purchase gift cards and provide the information to the caller, which he did. SO2100003399

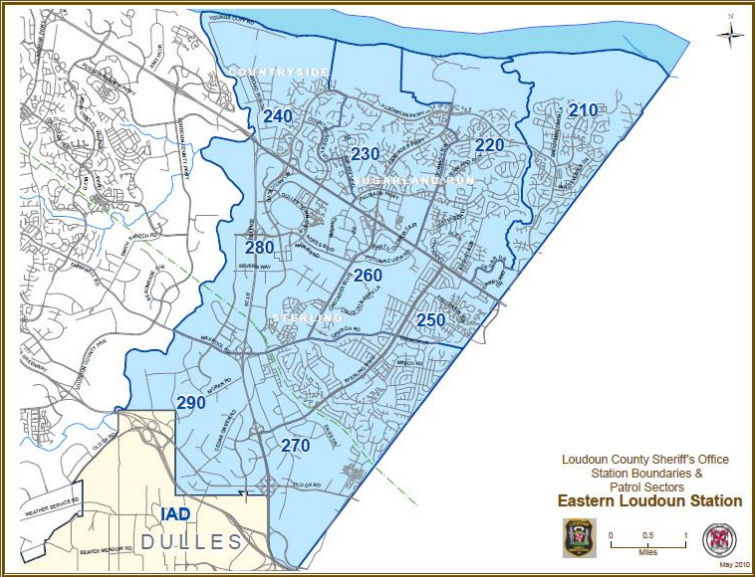

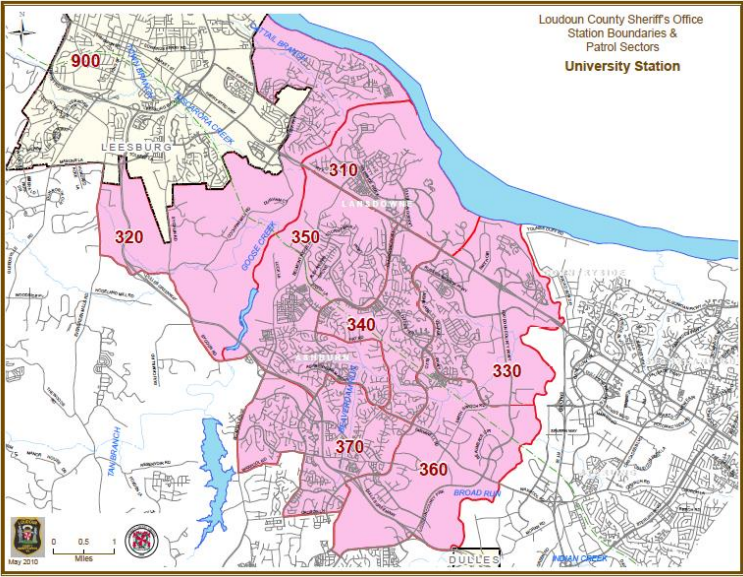

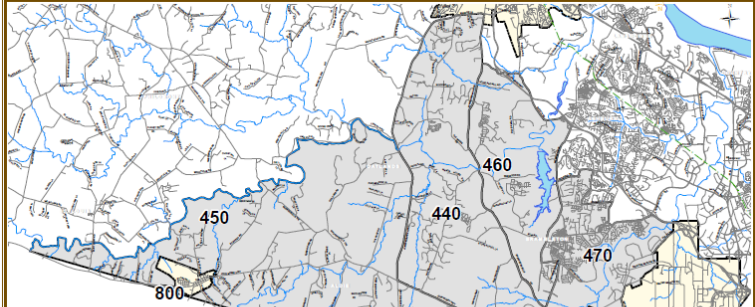
**Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2**
