Sterling	Destruction of Property (Update): A suspect was identified during the investigation into the vandalism at two shopping centers in Sterling. On March 4, the suspect, Kim M. McCoy, 46, of no fixed address was located and charged with three counts of felony destruction of property and one count of misdemeanor destruction of property. He remains held on no bond at the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center. Original Report (March 3): This morning the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office responded to multiple reports of vandalism at the Potomac Run Plaza and at Cascades Overlook that occurred sometime during the overnight or early morning hours. The windows of multiple businesses (Miller Ale House, Outback, Mattress Firm, Panera, Chuy's Mexican Restaurant) and a vehicle were damaged. The windows were damaged with rocks. 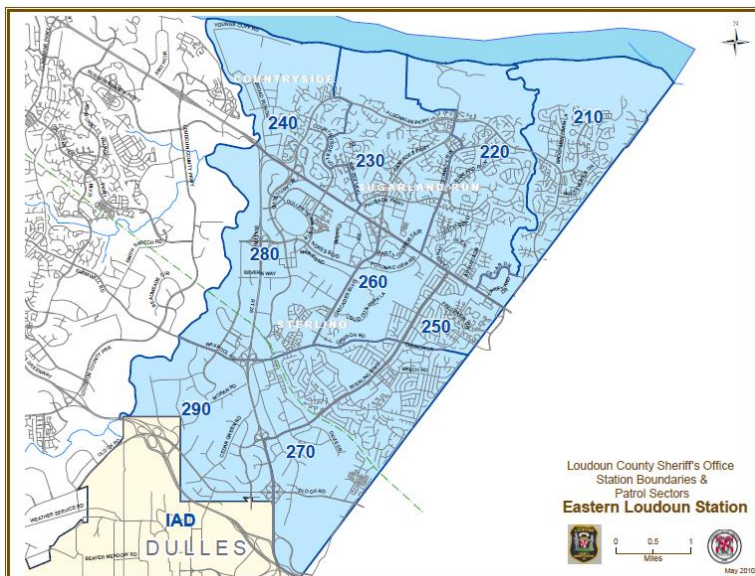

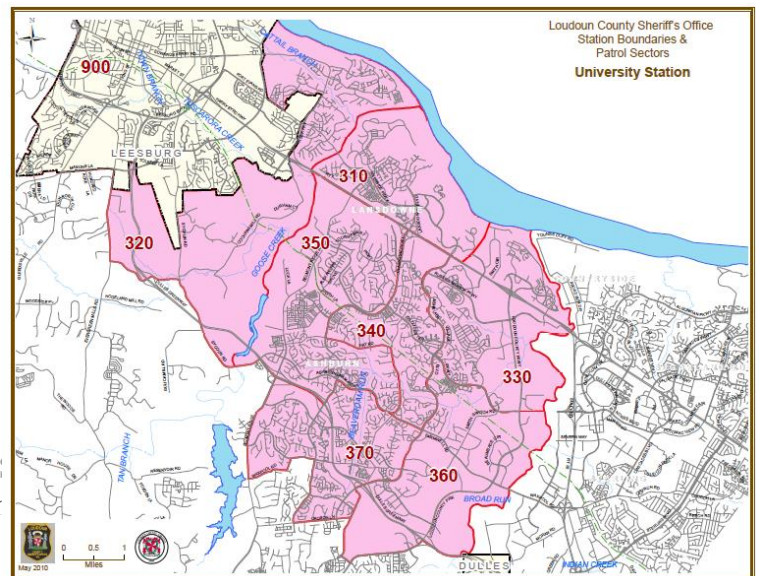


Station / Sector Maps

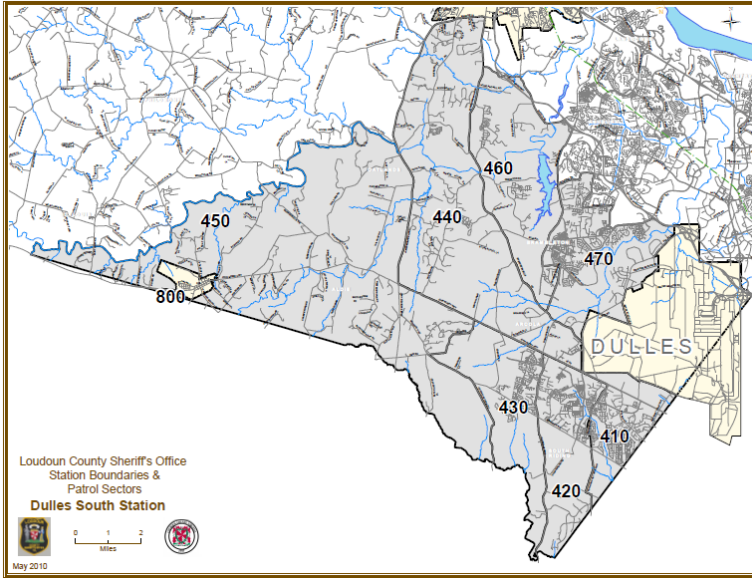
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
