



Loudoun County Hosts Free COVID-19 Testing Tomorrow, November 10

Loudoun County will host two free drive-thru testing events for COVID-19 tomorrow, November 10, 2020, from 10 AM to 1 PM. The testing events will take place at two locations simultaneously:

- Brambleton Community Park-West, 22377 Belmont Ridge Road in Brambleton
- Philip A. Bolen Memorial Park, 42405 Claudia Drive in Leesburg (enter the park from Sycolin Road onto Crosstrail Boulevard)

To help reduce wait times, people who plan to attend the testing event are strongly encouraged to complete a registration form for each person who will be receiving a test prior to arriving at the testing site. The fillable form is posted online:

Forms will also be available at the testing site. The registration form is required and asks for general demographics and contact information, including name, date of birth, address, phone number and current symptoms, if any.

The testing events are open to all. There are no age or residency requirements. No prescriptions or appointments are necessary. A person does not have to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 in order to be tested. A PCR test (nasal swab) will be administered, which tests for the novel coronavirus. Results will be available within a week. No antibody testing will be offered.

Virtual Public Briefing on Cellular Tower Proposal at Rock Ridge High School

Loudoun County Public Schools staff will be hosting a virtual public briefing on Wednesday, November 11, 2020 at 4 PM regarding a proposal from Milestone Communications for a 140-foot tall telecommunications facility (monopole) at Rock Ridge High School (43460 Loudoun Reserve Drive, Ashburn, VA 20148). AT&T would be the first wireless carrier to locate on the proposed monopole and there will be space for additional wireless providers.

The siting of the monopole on Loudoun County Public Schools (LCPS) property is guided by Loudoun County School Board Policy and Regulation 6350, Wireless Network Facility Colocation. The proposal will be reviewed by the School Board over the coming months. Milestone Communications must also obtain Loudoun County-required land use approvals and permits.
