



Loudoun County Hosts Free COVID-19 Testing Saturday, November 21

Loudoun County will host two free drive-thru testing events for COVID-19 on Saturday, November 21, 2020, from 10 AM to 1 PM. The testing events will take place at two locations simultaneously:

- * Freedom High School: 25450 Riding Center Drive, Chantilly (South Riding)
- * Franklin Park: 17501, Franklin Park Drive, Purcellville

The November 21 testing events are open to all. There are no age or residency requirements. No prescriptions or appointments are necessary. A person does not have to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 in order to be tested. A PCR test (nasal swab) will be administered at these testing events, which tests for the novel coronavirus. Results will be available within a week. No antibody or rapid tests will be offered.

To help reduce wait times, people who plan to attend the testing event are strongly encouraged to complete a registration form for each person who will be receiving a test prior to arriving at the testing site. The registration form is required and asks for general demographics and contact information, including

CTB Public Input Meeting November 24

Here's your chance to weigh in on vital transportation projects that will improve our quality of life in Dulles South! The Commonwealth Transportation Board will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, November 24 at 9 AM. The meeting will be held virtually due to COVID-19. You are invited to share comments on transportation projects that have been recommended for funding in the FY21-26 Six-Year Improvement Program. Comments will also be accepted on new projects valued above \$25 million.

The SYIP allocates public funding for projects such as highways, roads, bridges, rails, and bicycle and pedestrian facilities. Multiple Loudoun projects are currently being considered for addition to the SYIP, **including the Route 50 Northern Collector Road from Tall Cedars Parkway to Route 28.**
