



Metrorail Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements Virtual Meeting

On Thursday, October 22 from 6:30 - 8 PM, VDOT will host a virtual public information meeting to discuss bicycle and pedestrian improvements around future Metrorail stations in Loudoun County.

From VDOT

Find out about plans to construct missing segments in the bicycle and pedestrian network within two miles of the future Loudoun Gateway (Route 606) and Ashburn Metrorail stations. The improvements will occur along roads including Shellhorn Road, Wynridge Drive/Claude Moore Avenue, Ashburn Village Boulevard, Waxpool Road, Smith Switch Road, Route 606, Prentice Drive, Pacific Boulevard and Loudoun County Parkway. The project also includes pedestrian improvements at the intersections of Ashburn Village Boulevard and Shellhorn Road, Farmwell Road and Ashburn Village Boulevard, and Farmwell Road and Smith Switch Road.

Early Voting Has Begun at the Dulles South Senior Center

Early, in-person voting began this past weekend at the Dulles South Senior Center, located at 24950 Riding Center Drive. Early voting in Dulles South will continue until October 31. Voting is open on Saturdays from 9 AM - 5 PM; Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 10 AM - 6 PM; and Tuesdays and Thursdays from noon - 8 PM. Early voters do not need to apply or make appointments in advance, but should bring valid ID per state law. The Dulles South Senior Center is employing sanitization and social distancing measures during early voting, and face coverings are required.
