



Virtual Town Hall Meeting with Jeff Morse & Help Needed to Fight Greenway Toll Increases

We Need Your Help to Fight Toll Increases!

The owners of the Dulles Greenway have filed an application to increase tolls on the Greenway by over 6% annually over the next 5 years - a 30% increase. The County is fighting this proposal. In normal times, the State Corporation Commission would hold a field hearing in Loudoun to hear testimony on the rate increases. Because of COVID-19, that has been changed to a telephone public hearing on Tuesday, June 30 at 10:00 AM.

We need your testimony to help us fight this increase! We're particularly interested in hearing from residents and businesses that will no longer be able to use the Greenway because of these higher tolls. Residents and businesses that wish to comment via telephone during the Public Hearing can sign up in advance by visiting this [link](#). Comments can be up to 5 minutes long. The deadline to sign up is Friday, June 26 at 5:00 PM.
