



Loudoun County COVID-19 Testing Event This Wednesday

As we look to the future, I have been talking about three main criteria that I am using to help guide our recommendations to the Commonwealth on moving toward a Phase 1 reopening - the availability of COVID-19 testing, the availability of PPE, and a decrease in the actual daily number of COVID-19 patients.

To help address that first item, the Virginia Department of Health is partnering with Loudoun County Government to provide free, drive-through COVID-19 testing to all residents this Wednesday at Bolen Park in Leesburg from 10 AM - 6 PM. Details are below.

PPE availability is evaluated on a daily basis by County staff. The Board of Supervisors receives updates at our business meetings and via regular communications from staff. At this time, there have not been significant changes to PPE availability. Staff is continuing their efforts to procure essential items to supply our front line County employees and provide assistance to health care facilities in our County. COVID-19 Testing Event Details

Loudoun County will host free, drive-through testing for COVID-19 at Philip A. Bolen Memorial Park, 42405 Claudia Drive in Leesburg on Wednesday, May 20, 2020, from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM. The testing is open to all and will occur rain or shine.

No appointments are necessary. There are no age or residency requirements. A person does not have to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 in order to be tested. No prescription is necessary.

Anyone who is tested will be asked to provide contact information for the test results, which should be available within a week.

Those attending the testing will enter Philip A. Bolen Memorial Park from Crosstrail Boulevard onto Loudoun United Drive. They will be:

- Directed into parking lots and into lanes for drive-through testing.
- Asked for their name, date of birth, address, phone number and current symptoms, if any.
- Asked to proceed to the next station to have their specimen collected. A nasal swab is preferred, but oral swabs are available upon request.
- Asked to proceed to the exit.

This is a one-day event. No other testing dates are scheduled at this time.

Loudoun County encourages residents to stay informed about COVID-19.
