## Transit Summit

A Transit Summit is scheduled for Tuesday, May 25th at 6:00 pm. The Government Center Board Room will be open for residents who wish to view the meeting in person; however, you are encouraged to view the meeting remotely. The meeting will be televised on Comcast Government Channel 23 and Verizon FiOS Channel 40 and livestreamed on our [website](#).

At this meeting, we will get an update on several topics, including:

- The opening of the Metrorail Silver Line Phase 2 in Loudoun County, which will include a briefing from Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority General Manager Paul Wiedefeld.
- Comments on transit-related matters from several advisory boards, including the Commission on Aging, the Disability Services Board, the Loudoun Health Commission and the Transit Advisory Board.
- Findings from the Unmet Transit Needs of Seniors and Disabled Residents Study.
- Overview of the Loudoun County Transit route design and modification process to illustrate how transit routes are created to better meet community needs.
- Results of a study to identify strategies for the best use for the park and ride lots as Metrorail extends into Loudoun County.

## Vaccination Event Saturday

My Dr's Pharmacy is partnering with George Washington University's School of Nursing to do a high capacity vaccination event from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm at [GW VSTC Enterprise Hall](#), 44983 Knoll Square in Ashburn on May 15th for the first dose and June 5th for the second dose. Appointments are required: Please visit this [website](#) to schedule your appointment.

The Pfizer vaccine will be administered. Now that the FDA has approved eligibility for the Pfizer vaccine to children ages 12 to 15, there is a possibility that age group could be vaccinated at this event (pending CDC guidance). Children ages 12 to 15 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

In order to process your registration onsite, please bring a government-issued ID and your health insurance information. If you do not have health insurance, you can still receive your COVID-19 vaccine free of charge.
