**Avonlea II Project Virtual Community Meeting

A new version of the Avonlea project has been proposed by Peterson Companies and was recently approved by the Planning Commission and found to be largely consistent with the County Comprehensive Plan by County staff.

COVID-19 Testing Event Friday in South Riding

Loudoun provides free COVID-19 PCR (nasal swab) testing weekly. This week, the drive-through testing is being held at the Dulles South Rec Center, located at 24950 Riding Center Drive in South Riding. The first testing event was Tuesday, and the **next one will be on Friday, February 11 from 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.**

Testing is open to everyone: there are no age, residency, or ID requirements. You do not need to be exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 to be tested. To help reduce wait times, please fill out a registration form before arriving. Forms are available in [English](#) and [Spanish](#). It is also highly recommended that you arrive early. Thank you for your continued patience with the staff running the events. Your results should be available within a week after taking a test.
