On November 30, 2023, Richard L. Edmundson, 35, of no fixed address, was arrested in connection with the shooting on November 27, 2023, in the parking lot of the Dulles Retail Plaza in Sterling. The LCSO's investigation has determined that there was more than one individual involved in this incident, and the identification of the additional individuals remains under investigation. Edmundson was charged with Malicious Wounding and transported to the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center where he is being held on no bond. The victim remains hospitalized in stable condition. Shopping Safety: PURSE & WALLET THEFT

It can happen very quickly, you look or walk away from your shopping cart for a couple of seconds, and when you turn back around, your purse or items from within your purse are gone.

SAFETY TIPS

- Carry only what you need - if you do not need it to shop, leave it home including your purse, credit cards, store cards, money, etc.
- Zip your purse so thieves can't reach in and grab your wallet.
