The Loudoun County Board of Supervisors has proclaimed February as Black History Month in Loudoun. The Board's resolution, adopted last Tuesday night, states that "throughout the rich and impressive history of Loudoun County, Americans of African heritage substantially and significantly contributed to the educational, economic, social and spiritual well-being of Loudoun County in ways too numerous to count."

This resolution points out that history was made in Loudoun County in November 2015 when you elected the first two African Americans to serve on the Board of Supervisors.
