My office just received information of a Town Hall meeting regarding **overcrowding at Dulles South Middle Schools**.

School Board Members Jeff Morse (Dulles District) and Beth Huck (At-Large) will be hosting a Town Hall **this Thursday, February 11th at 7:00 pm in the Mercer Middle School Auditorium** to discuss the severe overcrowding at Dulles South Middle Schools, and potential courses of action.

Mr. Morse will present a summary of enrollment and capacity concerns and mitigation options. Mercer Middle School Principal Bob Phillips will provide an overview of how potential courses of action would be executed. Following the presentations, a question and answer session will be held.

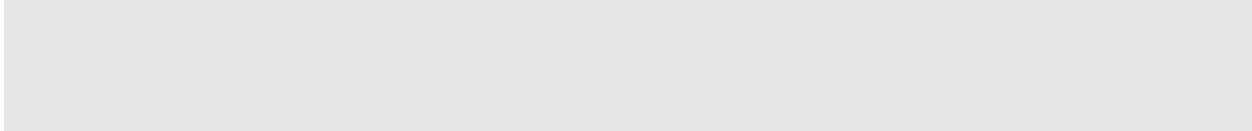

The School Board review is associated with the opening of MS-9 in 2017 and the proposed opening of HS-11 in 2019, both in the Brambleton area.
