



Additional Community Meeting in Brambleton Regarding Proposed Belmont Ridge Neighborhood

Last week, Toll Brothers held a community meeting for Brambleton homeowners regarding its application to develop a 6.95 acre property located on the west side of Belmont Ridge Road between Fresh Rain Square and Franklin Benjamin Terrace.

Because the initial meeting occurred while many were on spring break, I requested that Toll Brothers conduct an additional meeting to which they have agreed. I appreciate Toll Brothers' willingness to conduct another meeting in order to allow additional community input regarding the proposal.

This additional meeting will be held at **7pm on Tuesday, April 19th** at the **Brambleton Community Center** (42645 Regal Wood Drive, Ashburn, VA 20148).

For those who may not have seen my previous email, Toll Brothers is seeking a zoning map amendment to permit 43 single family attached homes (townhomes) on the property listed above. Renderings and layouts of the proposed townhome development will be available for viewing at the meeting.
