Dear Western Loudoun Residents,

We would like to thank the hundreds of residents who came out to Monday night's meeting with AT&T to discuss the Commission Permit application to expand the existing facility on Short Hill. Your attendance illustrated the significant impact this facility will have on Western Loudoun County. We continue to share the concerns expressed by many of you about this facility on Short Hill. In our opinion, many questions still remain and we remain opposed to the current application.



For those of you who were not able to attend Loudoun Now posted a great [article](#) on last night's meeting.



We know many of you have been following this issue very closely so we wanted to provide you with updated background information and to remind you that the next action for this item will be at the June 23rd Board of Supervisors Business Meeting.

This application was heard by the Planning Commission on [April 26, 2016](#) . Unfortunately, the Planning Commission approved the Commission Permit by a vote of 6-2-1. The Board of Supervisors then reviewed the item at the [May 19, 2016](#) Board of Supervisors Business Meeting and voted to report the item back to the Board Business Meeting on June 23, 2016 for final action. Unlike a land development application, there are no conditions of approval for a Commission Permit and once the Planning Commission has acted the Board of Supervisors must take action to either ratify or overrule the Planning Commission's approval of the Commission Permit (CMPT-2016-0001, AT&T Short Hill) within 60 days of the Planning Commission action by June 25, 2016.
