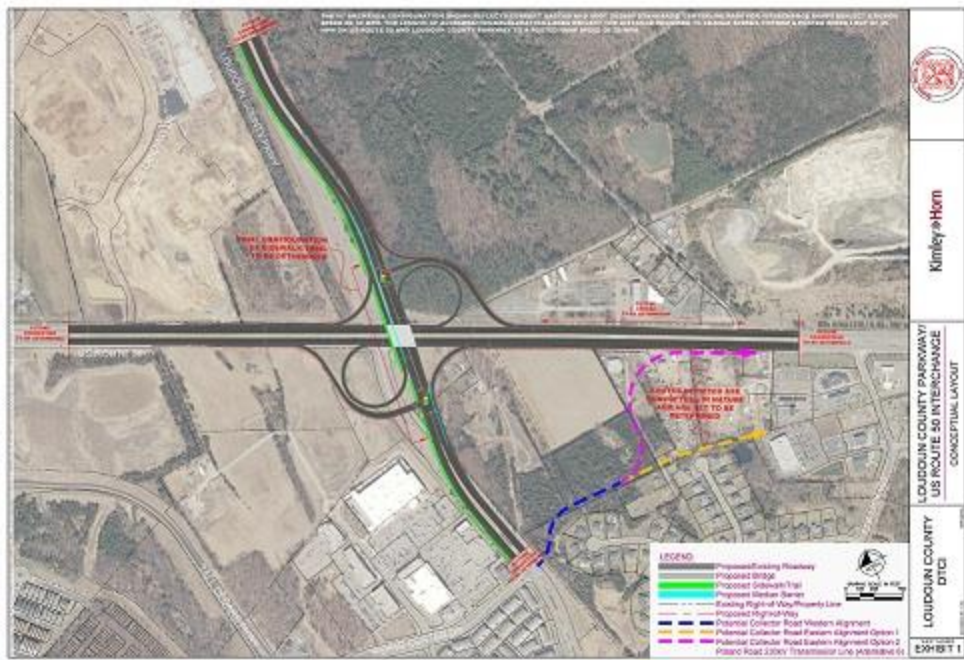
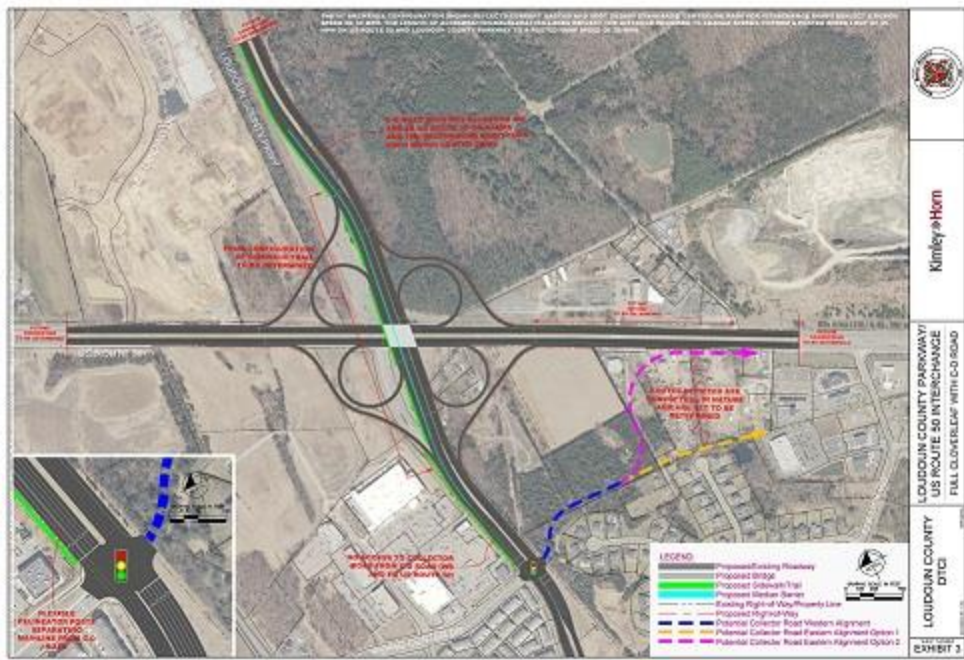


Informational Meeting on Design Options for Loudoun County Parkway/Route 50 Interchange

On **Tuesday, August 30th, at 6:30 p.m. in the Liberty Elementary School Cafeteria** (25491 Riding Center Drive, South Riding), the Loudoun County Department of Transportation and Capital Infrastructure (DTCI) will hold an informational meeting to discuss the two design options the Board of Supervisors is currently evaluating for the Loudoun County Parkway/Route 50 Interchange.

Exhibits will be presented at the meeting showing the locations and impacts, benefits, and drawbacks of each design. This is the initial stage for interchange design, and will be followed by a state-mandated Interchange Justification Report (IJR) and design and engineering. As such, this is first of many opportunities for citizens and business leaders to provide input into the design of this interchange. The two design options under consideration are: a Full Cloverleaf and Partial Cloverleaf (shown below).
