

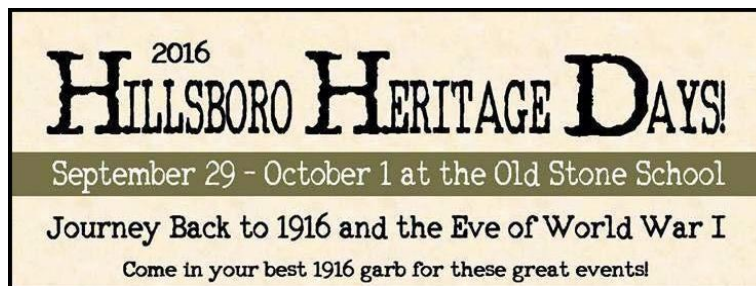
Community Heritage Days and Brambleton Fall Festival

I wanted to inform of some upcoming events that I hope you're able to attend!

Hillsboro Heritage Days: September 29th - October 1st

For three days, Hillsboro will be transported back 100 years to the fall of 1916. Hillsboro Heritage Days will capture the context and feel of the fall of 1916, as Virginians pondered the prospect of war, prepared to vote for president, reacted to the Commonwealth's new prohibition law, and debated whether Virginian women should be allowed to vote.



This year's [Hillsboro Heritage Days](#) will be among the first events in Loudoun County's three-year World War I Commemoration program, and one of the first WWI commemorative events in the Commonwealth.
