### **ROUTE 15 CONGESTION REPORT**

The Route 15 Congestion Report was presented to the Board of Supervisors on May 18, 2017. It provides an analysis of improvements identified to relieve congestion on Route 15 north of the Town of Leesburg. The report builds on previous studies that were prepared by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) and the Town of Leesburg. The Board also directed staff to conduct a study of the safety and operational issues on Route 15 between Whites Ferry Road and the Maryland state line to identify progressive improvements that can be implemented.
