to the Fiscal Year 2019 Capital Improvement Program budget deliberation process.

This along with two other motions to continue working on pedestrian and bicycle connectivity in this corridor along with overall safety for everyone brings us one step closer to much needed improvements along the Sterling Route 7 corridor.
