For those following this important issue, I wanted to let you know that the search for a potential alternate site for the Aldie Fire Station has been narrowed to only a few remaining parcels within the acceptable area.

County staff continues to further explore these options and I remain hopeful that a positive solution will be identified.

As has been previously reported, design work on the current site remains ongoing and I am happy to report that while we remain hopeful an alternate site will be

identified, the Aldie Heritage Association has expressed interest in being included in the design process for the current site and my office will ensure this occurs.
