Loudoun Comprehensive Plan

There are various ways to communicate to the Board of Supervisors about the comprehensive plan.

1. Speak at one of the Board of Supervisors public hearings scheduled this week on Wednesday, April 24th at 6:00 pm at the Government Center, 1 Harrison Street in Leesburg or Saturday, April 27th at 9:00 am at the LCPS Administration Building, 21000 Education Court in Ashburn. Advanced sign-up is encouraged by calling the Clerk at 703-777-0200.
2. Videotape your comments on a first-come, first-served basis during one of the two public hearings; video recording will end when the public hearing adjourns. All video-recorded comments will be provided to the Board following the public hearings.
3. Speak to the Board at the business meetings on the 1st Tuesday and 3rd Thursday of every month at 6:30 pm. The 6:30 pm public input session is limited to 60 minutes total. At the second business meeting of the month, an additional public input session is included at the beginning of the agenda at 5:00 pm, which is limited to 8 speakers who must sign up in advance by calling the Clerk.

4. E-mail the Board of Supervisors at bos@loudoun.gov.

Please see the approved work session schedule below. The public is welcome to attend these sessions in the board room of the Government Center but there is no public input. According to state statute, the Board has 90 days from certification by the Planning Commission to adopt the comprehensive plan, and the tentative date for approval is June 20th.

The Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services (PRCS) and Parks, Recreation and Open Space Board are holding a public input session regarding a comprehensive, countywide linear parks and trails system. The meeting is scheduled for 7 pm on Thursday, April 25th at PRCS Administration, 742 Miller Drive in Leesburg. The public input session will consist of a brief presentation about the initiative and stakeholder meetings, small group facilitated discussions and a compilation of results, which will be shared with the Board this summer.

In January, I sponsored a Board Member Initiative to develop a detailed implementation plan for a countywide network of linear parks and trails called Emerald Ribbons. I'm so pleased citizens brought this idea to me and am glad to see it moving forward.

Stadium Groundbreaking

The County broke ground on a new soccer stadium at Philip A. Bolen Memorial Park in Leesburg on March 26th. The stadium is expected to be ready for Loudoun United's inaugural match, which is scheduled for August 9, 2019. The stadium, with a seating capacity of approximately 5,000, will be home to the Loudoun United FC professional soccer team. It also will be

available for other community events, such as youth sports tournaments, graduations and concerts.

The excitement around the team is palpable. Everyone knows it, everyone feels it and everyone talks about it. Our kids will benefit from the use of amazing soccer fields and talented players to learn from and the County will benefit from the positive economic impact associated with soccer tournaments and visitors' expenditures at businesses in Loudoun.



At the April 2nd Board business meeting, I sponsored a Board Member Initiative to study the demand and unmet transportation needs of the senior and disabled residents in Loudoun County. The total number of FY 2019 on-demand trips that have been turned down through December 31st is 162 or an average of 27 per month. It is important to note that these are the trips that staff are aware of and does not include any unmet demand from riders that may have stopped calling because they have been unsuccessful in booking a ride. I hope to identify the need and provide transportation solutions for the senior and disabled residents in Loudoun County.

Thank you and I look forward to meeting you at the Loudoun Comprehensive Plan public hearings this week and my State of the County Address in May.
