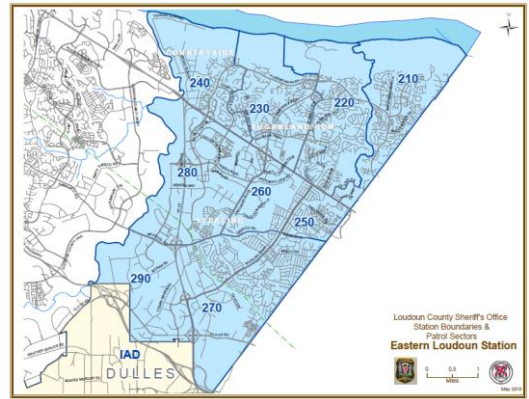

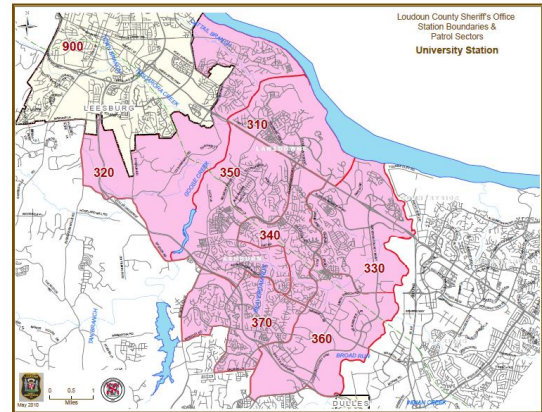

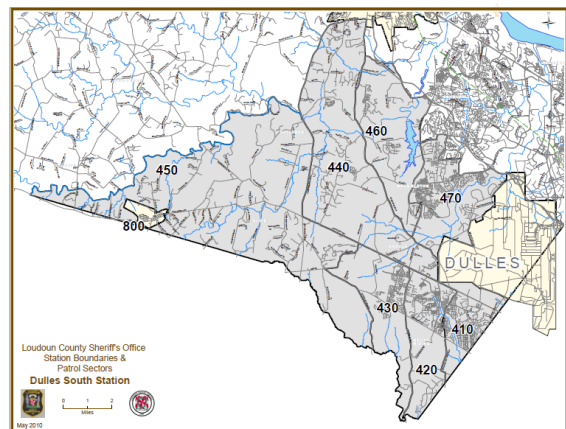

Dulles South Station

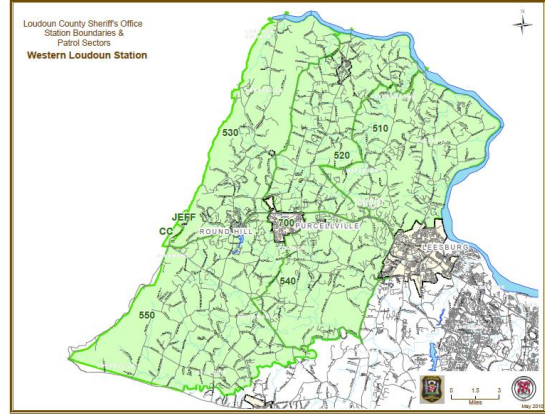
