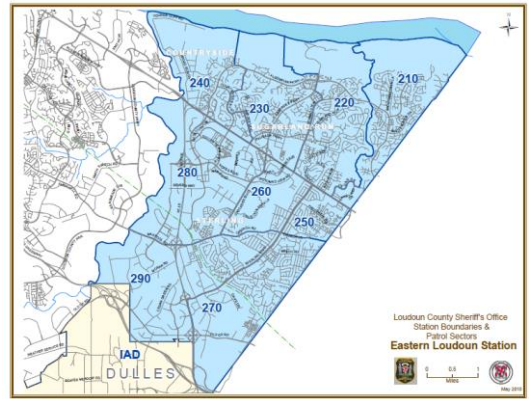
Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Daily Crime Report

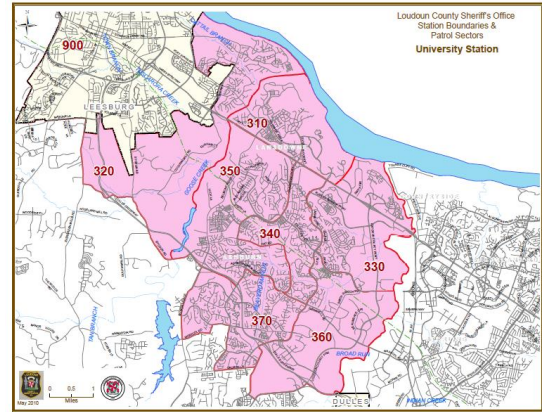

A deputy observed the subjects enter a vehicle and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The suspect vehicle continued and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit continued through Sterling and entered Fairfax County. The Fairfax County Police Department joined the pursuit and followed the vehicle until it crossed the state line into Maryland. The suspect vehicle was later involved in a pursuit in Montgomery County and was apprehended by the Montgomery County Police Department. 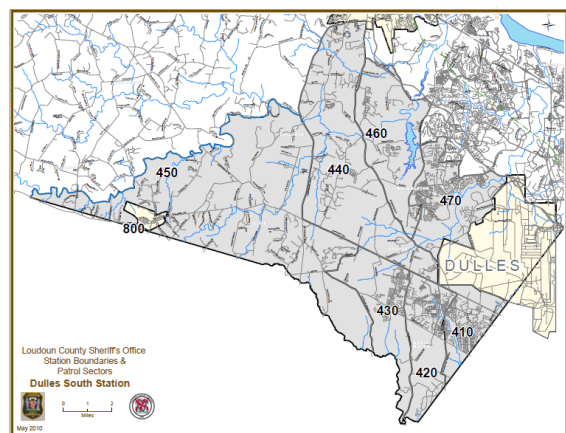

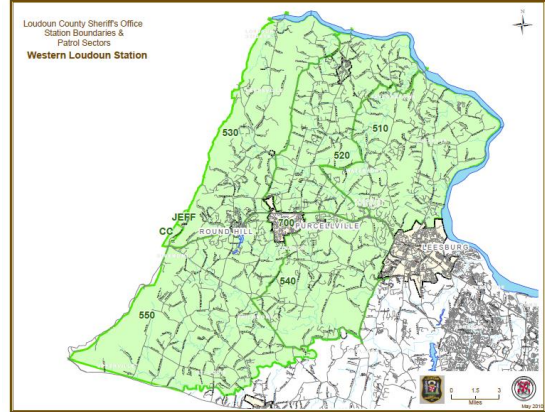
