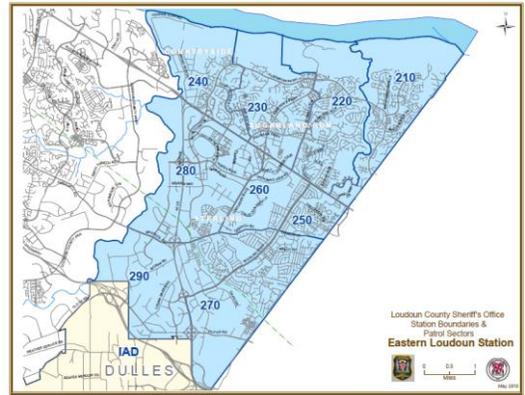
Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Daily Crime Report







<p>1/11/2020 0510 hrs.</p>	<p>Harmony Church Rd./ Peale Lane Leesburg</p>	<p>Crash: The Loudoun County Sheriff's Office is investigating a fatal crash near Leesburg.</p> <p>The crash occurred around 5:10 a.m. Saturday in the area of Harmony Church Road near Peale Lane. The driver of a Nissan Juke was traveling eastbound on Harmony Church Road when his vehicle entered the opposite lane of travel and into the path of an oncoming Ford F-150.</p> <p>The driver of the Nissan, Phillip S. Heffelfinger, 31, of Ashburn lost his life at the scene. The driver of the Ford was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.</p> <p>The crash remains under investigation by the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office Crash Reconstruction Unit.
