New Online Maps for COVID-19 Resources

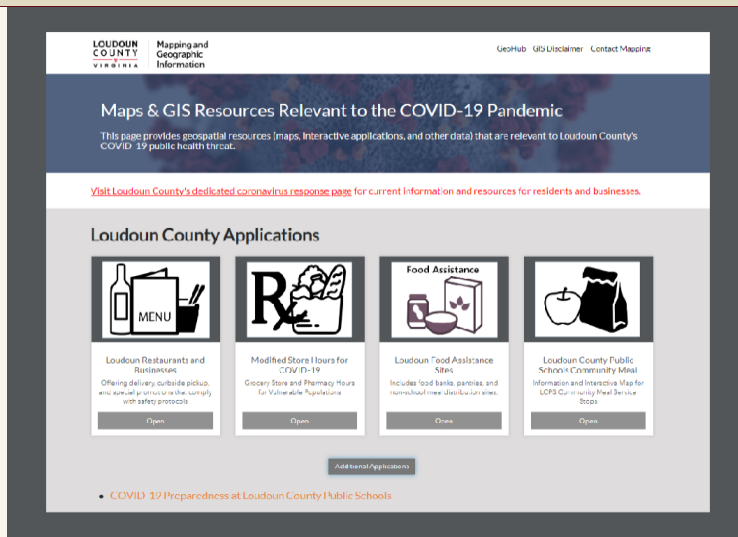
Grocery Stores (Special Shopping Hours), Pharmacies, Restaurants (Takeout/Delivery), Food Banks, LCPS Meals

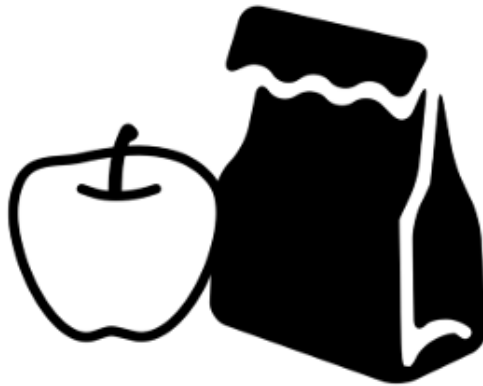
