COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund Applications Due Tomorrow

The Loudoun Economic Development Authority will be accepting applications for a third round of COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund grants until noon tomorrow. The Loudoun County Board of Supervisors unanimously approved an additional \$2 million in grant funding for the COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund to support Loudoun businesses impacted by the coronavirus outbreak. This funding was allocated from the \$36.1 million in

grants until noon tomorrow. The Loudoun County Board of Supervisors unanimously approved an additional \$2 million in grant funding for the COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund to support Loudoun businesses impacted by the coronavirus outbreak. This funding was allocated from the \$36.1 million in

federal funding made available to the county through the CARES Act. The fund will provide 400 randomly selected applicant businesses with a \$5,000 grant.

Applicants must demonstrate the following criteria:

- Have between zero and two W-2 employees (no limit on 1099 contractors);
- Have less than \$2.5 million in gross annual receipts;
- Have at least a 25% loss in revenue that can be attributed to COVID-19;
- Be a licensed and operational for-profit business in Loudoun County, Va.
- If the applicant business received a grant from the COVID-19 Business Interruption Fund in the first or second rounds, they are not eligible to apply again.

The fund is now open for applications and will remain open until noon on June 6, 2020. All submissions will be accepted based on the time stamp that the application was received, verified by county employees, and placed into a pool, where businesses will be randomly selected until the funding has expired.

The Department of Animal Services is expanding its Companion Animal Resource Effort (CARE) program to help families affected by COVID-19. Grants up to \$150 are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Funds may be approved for medical needs, prescriptions, prescription food and certain other pet wellness supplies.
