WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

- Explain that an emergency is a situation where they need the help of a police officer, firefighter, or doctor. Teach them how to dial 911 in an emergency and have your child practice giving the following information: nature of the emergency, full name, address, and telephone number.
- Talk about what to do when they need help if it is not an emergency. Designate safe-neighbors, friends, or family members.
- Post phone numbers by the phone or on the fridge which include parents and caregivers work and cell phone numbers as well as phone numbers for designated safe-neighbors, friends, or family members.

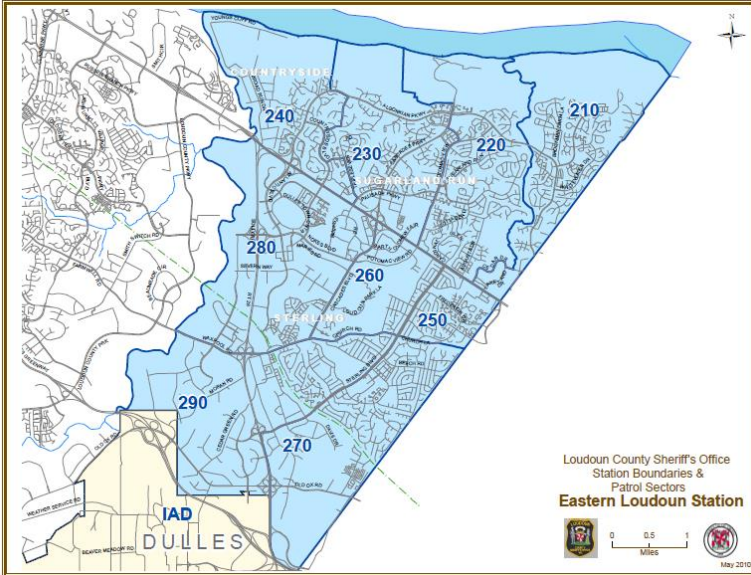


KEEPING LOUDOUN COUNTY YOUTH SAFE

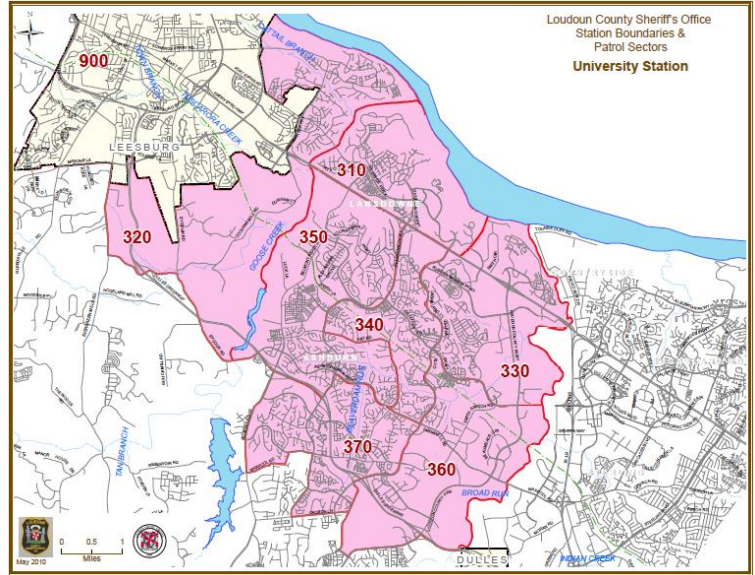


Loudoun County Sheriff's Office STATION / SECTOR MAPS

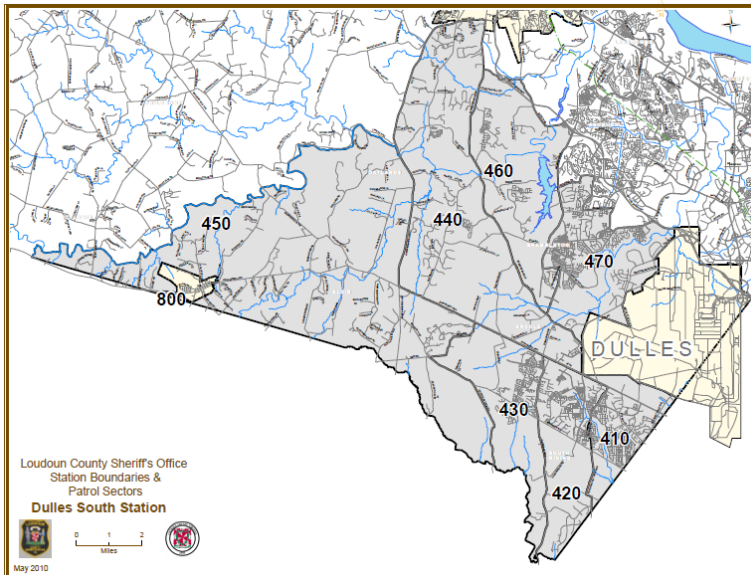
Eastern Loudoun Station: SECTOR 2
