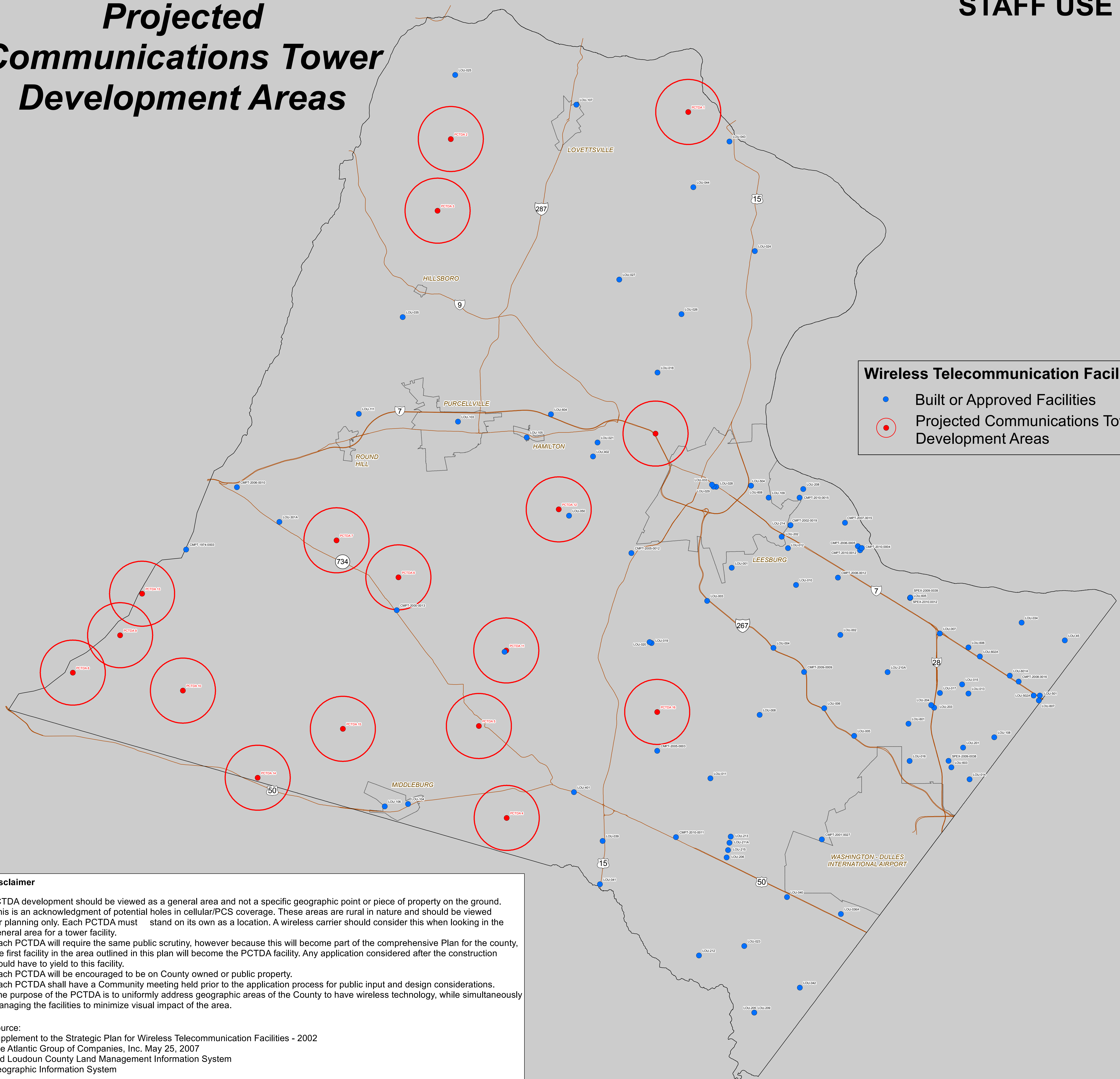


# Projected Communications Tower Development Areas

**Disclaimer**

PCTDA development should be viewed as a general area and not a specific geographic point or piece of property on the ground. -This is an acknowledgment of potential holes in cellular/PCS coverage. These areas are rural in nature and should be viewed for planning only. Each PCTDA must stand on its own as a location. A wireless carrier should consider this when looking in the general area for a tower facility.

- Each PCTDA will require the same public scrutiny, however because this will become part of the comprehensive Plan for the county, the first facility in the area outlined in this plan will become the PCTDA facility. Any application considered after the construction would have to yield to this facility.
- Each PCTDA will be encouraged to be on County owned or public property.
- Each PCTDA shall have a Community meeting held prior to the application process for public input and design considerations.
- The purpose of the PCTDA is to uniformly address geographic areas of the County to have wireless technology, while simultaneously managing the facilities to minimize visual impact of the area.
