Upon conclusion of the academy participants have the option of applying for a ride-along with a Deputy during a tour of duty.

- Age: 18 years or older
- Residence: Loudoun County resident, employee, or business owner
- Citizenship: US or Permanent Resident
 - Must be of good moral character
 - Have not been convicted of a felony or Class 1 Misdemeanor.
 - No outstanding warrants or pending criminal charges
