

# KEEP HALLOWEEN SAFE

## during COVID-19

### NOT RECOMMENDED

- **Door-to-door trick or treating. It is considered high risk for COVID-19 transmission.**
- Trick-or-treating or trunk-or-treat events where individuals are not wearing a face covering and where 6 feet of distance is not maintained.
- Crowded events.
- Indoor haunted houses.
- Hayrides or tractor rides with people who are not in your household.
- Traveling to and from areas outside your community.

### RECOMMENDED

- **Staying home and away from others if you are sick, COVID-19 positive, or been in contact with someone who is sick.**
- Staying 6 feet away from others in public.
- Washing your hands before and after participating in any activities. Take hand sanitizer with you.
- Wearing a cloth face covering. Halloween costume masks may not protect against respiratory droplets.
- Contactless ways to deliver treats.
- Lower risk activities that can be enjoyed with family and friends at a safe distance: pumpkin carving, decorating outside, outdoor costume parades at a safe distance, virtual Halloween costume contests.
