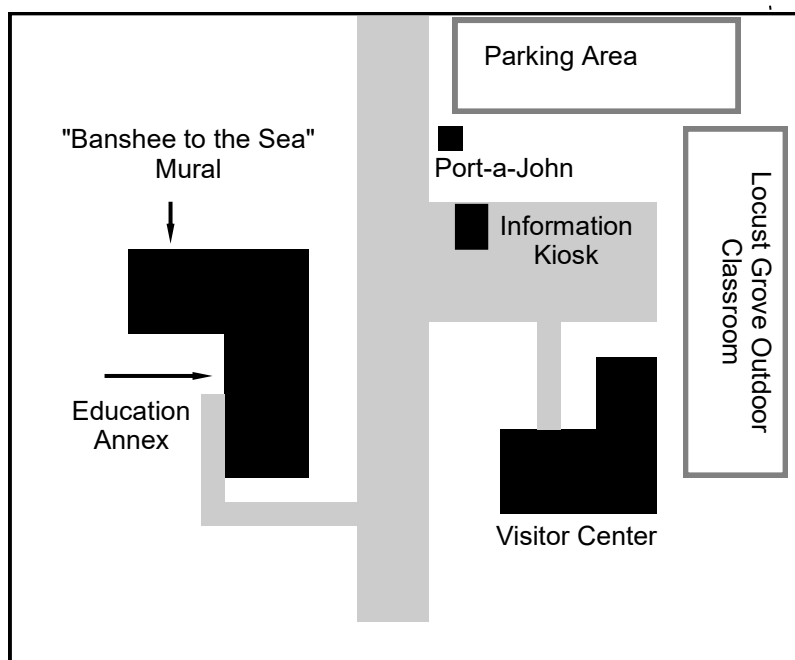
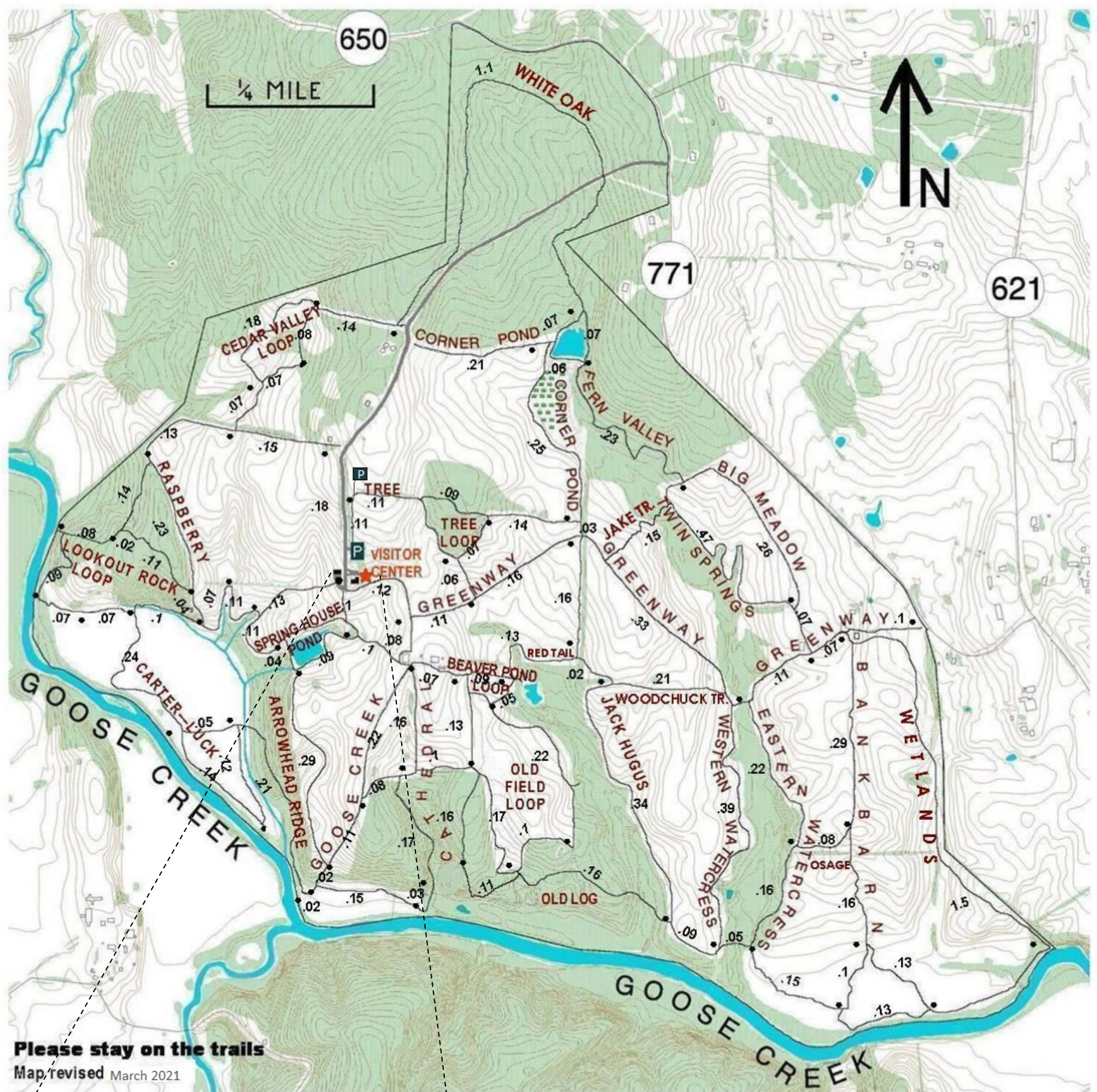


# BANSHEE REEKS TRAIL MAP



## Discover Your Outdoors

Banshee Reeks has been designated a Virginia State Treasure. It is operated as a nature preserve by the Loudoun County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services. It is supported by the Friends of Banshee Reeks, a volunteer, nonprofit organization. The preserve strives to protect the natural habitats and wildlife populations of Banshee Reeks, to conduct and coordinate ecological, historical and other scientific research, and to provide the public with an opportunity to enjoy and learn from this unique area.

The Preserve consists of 695 acres of forests, succession fields, ponds, and streams. The Goose Creek, a State Scenic River, flows for over two miles along the southern border of the property. There are 20 miles of mowed hiking trails.

We recommend downloading the free app Avenza Maps to your smartphone. Available on Android and iOS, Avenza puts our trail map on your phone and shows your location in BRNP in real time.

\*Please note that the Carter-Luck Trail is labelled as Bluebell Trail on the trail markers.
